Dear Parent/Carer

As we draw closer to the conclusion of this academic year, we write to inform you of some changes to our Sixth Form provision for 2017-18. The decision has been made to centralise all Sixth Form students and lessons to Cornwallis Academy from September 2017. We firmly believe this will promote the sense of community within our already thriving Sixth Form, and provide the consistency required for academic success at key stage 5, as it will no longer be necessary for students to travel between the two sites.

Please be assured that all courses started in 2016-17 will continue to run as planned as stated in our terms and conditions, and will simply be provided at Cornwallis rather than New Line Learning. In addition, the majority of staff delivering courses at New Line Learning will continue to do so at Cornwallis from September.

To ensure a smooth transition process, students who have enrolled on courses based at New Line Learning Academy will be provided with support and advice on how to apply for a bursary fund which will cover the cost of a bus pass if required. Application forms for both bursary fund and bus passes are available from the Sixth Form office, or from the Sixth Form section of the school's website under the 'how to apply' tab. I would advise you to return the completed forms as soon as possible in order to ensure they are processed in time for bus passes to be issued for September 2017.


We are confident that current and future students will benefit from belonging to one centralised Sixth Form community, and we look forward to working closely with you as parents and carers to ensure a seamless transition.
